Important Member Information

Our next production

Our next production is "Calamity Jane" and will be performed in Eden Court Theatre. We will be in the theatre from $23^{\rm rd}$ to $28^{\rm th}$ March 2015. We have two shows on the $28^{\rm th}$ March; a matinee performance and an evening performance.

Our rehearsals

Our first rehearsal will be Thursday 4th September 2014 at 7.15pm at Millburn Academy, Inverness. This is an opportunity to meet and greet new and existing faces who are all taking part in the show. You'll also get to meet the Committee, and Production staff. We normally have a brief sing-through, and then some refreshments to socialise!

Following first rehearsal, chorus rehearsals will take place every Thursday until October. We have a 2 week break for the October holidays. After this, all members should make themselves available on all Tuesdays and Thursdays until December. Sometimes you won't be needed at every rehearsal but this will be the decision of the production staff, who will provide rehearsal schedules. After the Christmas break, we rehearse every Tuesday and Thursday up to show week. We also have 2 Sunday rehearsals and these will be 15^{th} and 22^{nd} March (in the afternoons, not evenings). Additional rehearsals may be required, and this is at the discretion of production staff.

You need to be able to learn the music, dance moves (if you have them) and lines (if you have them). You do have books to start with, but as you get to learn the music you don't generally use these from around November onwards. You will be directed by the Production staff - Director (Caroline Nicol) Musical Director (Fiona Stuart), Assistant Director (Lesley MacLean) and Stage Director (George Reynolds). They will keep you right!

It is essential that you can commit as best as you can to attending rehearsals. Of course we understand that there are personal and work commitments that cannot be avoided and we do our very best to accommodate this, however we do have to act in the best interests of the company and the production. If you are unable to make rehearsal, please inform the Director, Caroline Nicol of your absence. Poor attendance may unfortunately result in you being asked to leave the production and we certainly don't want that!

Auditions

Production staff decide on the audition pieces and will advise you of these. You can then fill out an audition form. The auditions will take place on 7th October. An audition schedule will be put together so you have an idea of when you should attend. We have a casting committee which is normally made up of the Director, Musical Director, and two other experienced members or past members of Inverness Opera Company.

Once decisions have been made, you will be informed by email. It is your responsibility to ensure that we have your correct email and contact information and to ensure that our address is added to your contact list to prevent our mails going to your junk or spam folders. If you are unsuccessful in getting the part you wanted, don't worry – you will have a place on stage! You may wish to be considered for another part or may decide to stay with the chorus. You do not need to audition for a chorus part.

Show Week

The run up to show week is very busy and the atmosphere is fantastic! Everyone's getting excited (and nervous) and looking forward to getting into the theatre to perform in front of an audience! We arrive at Eden Court on Monday 23^{rd} of March and have a technical rehearsal on the stage from 7pm. This is to allow the setup of staging, lighting and sound. A full dress rehearsal (costumes, hair, makeup) is held on Tuesday 24^{th} . Our opening night is Wednesday 25^{th} March at 7.30pm!

Dressing rooms are provided for all cast members, and we also arrange short tours for those who have never been backstage before. You will get instructions and detailed information on the arrangements from production and committee closer to the time.

Non performing roles

We also have plenty of opportunities for those who may not wish to be on stage. A lot of work happens behind the scenes, and jobs include props, costumes, publicity and backstage crew. There's always something needing to be done!

Publicity and advertising

We obviously want to sell the show as best we can, so all the stops are pulled out to get lots of tickets sold. We all have a responsibility as members, to get the word out among friends/family/businesses in order to raise awareness of our production. We also carry out a lot of press work and sometimes this may require you to be available for a photo opportunity, or a short "teaser" video, or sometimes pop up for our well-loved flashmobs! The more we do, the more we sell!
