



The Story

"FINIAN'S RAINBOW" is set in the mythical Rainbow Valley in the equally mythical State of Missitucky, U.S.A.— where the tobacco crop (and the imagination) run riot. Finian McLonergan has purloined a crock of gold from Og, the Leprechaun, and in company with his daughter, Sharon, has left Ireland for America, where he hopes to see his gold grow bigger "like everything else here." They gain instant popularity with the local sharecroppers and their leader, Woody Mahoney, by helping them out of their money problems, but fall foul of the Negro-hating Senator Billboard Rawkins, and his aide, Buzz Collins. Og, the Leprechaun, who is gradually turning human because he has lost his magic crock (a 3-wish model), tracks Finian down, but finds himself strangely attracted to Sharon, who in turn, has fallen for Woody.

Finian, having safely buried the crock, uses his own brand of economic theory, puts Rainbow Valley on the Gold Standard and initiates the locals into the wonders of credit-buying through the agency of a visit from Mr Hire and Mr Purchase. Rawkins has by now learned that the gold is hidden on his land and attempts a take-over bid which is unwittingly foiled when Sharon uses the first of the three wishes to turn the Senator black.

Sharon and Woody are arrested for witchcraft, but Og saves the day. Now almost completely human, he has fallen in love with Susan the Silent, Woody's deaf and dumb sister. He uses the second wish to restore her speech, and with the third, dramatically turns Rawkins white again. As the crock is thus rendered worthless, Finian sets out once more on his endless search for his own particular Glocca-Morra, leaving Woody and Sharon, Og and Susan, and, indeed, everyone in Rainbow Valley, to live happily ever after.






