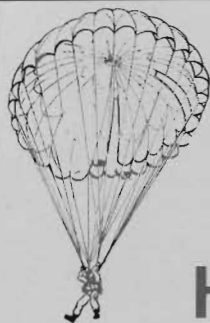

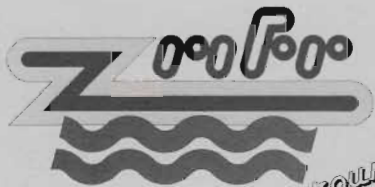

Synopsis of Story

Set in Russia in 1905, when one of the first revolutionary uprisings was put down harshly by the Tsar. The story revolves around Tevye, the milkman for Anatevka, a village in the Pale of Settlement of Jews. Tevye has a domineering wife Golde, no less than five daughters and a delivery horse with a bad leg; but despite these afflictions his spirit is high and his head sings to the music of the Fiddler. If God visits him with misfortune it is His will and although it may be questioned, it must be accepted. Tradition will see Tevye and the Jews through all adversity even chastening pogroms by the Tsar's police meant to remind the Jews that they are second-class citizens. The story moves forward to show how Tevye reacts to the changing times. His children are progressive despite a strict upbringing and scorn the services of Yente, the matchmaker. Tevye's belief in Tradition as a creed for living is tested when the three eldest daughters Tzeitel, Hodel and Chava, arrange their own marriages with Motel, a childhood sweetheart, Perchik, a radical student and Fyedka, a Russian policeman. The other characters are people in the village including Lazer Wolf, the butcher, a rich man and a widower who is spurned by Tzeitel, the Rabbi and his over-smart son Mendel, Reb Mordcha, the Innkeeper and Avram, the Bookseller, who all play a part in fleshing out Tevye's story, a story all the more affecting as it is based on the truth.

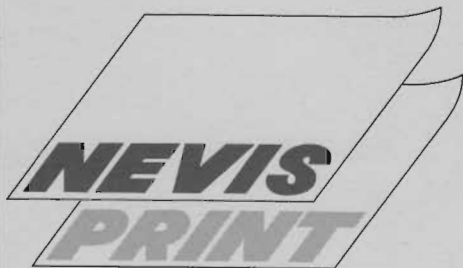
