'Die Fledermaus' — A Synopsis



The play, set in Vienna in 1874, gets its title 'The Bat' from the disguise worn by Dr Falke at a previous fancy dress ball, and depicts his plan for revenge on Gabriel Eisenstein for a prank played on him there.

In Act I Falke persuades Gabriel, about to serve a brief prison sentence for a light-hearted offence, to attend, disguised as a Marquis, a ball given by Prince Orlofsky. Gabriel's wife Rosalinda, who has arranged to let her ardent admirer Alfred console her, is tricked into attending the ball disguised as a mysterious masked Countess. The presence of Frank, the prison governor is also ensured. Rosalinda's maid, Adele has her own plan to grace the ball as an actress. When, too late, Frank arrives to escort Gabriel to prison, it is Alfred who, discovered in dressing gown and tête-a-tête with Rosalinda and thus undeniably her 'husband', is marched off.

In Act II, at the sumptuous ball, Gabriel flirts with the unrecognised 'Countess', who coaxes from him a little watch — to be used mischievously later — while Frank falls in love with Adele, the pretty 'actress'.

In Act III, back on duty at the jail next morning Governor Frank, suffering painful morning-after symptoms, is less than sympathetic to the outraged protests of his prisoner, the supposed Gabriel. Not until all the characters are eventually reassembled is the mischief sorted out, and, with the help of King Champagne, happiness once more reigns.
