



After the success of last year's summer production – "Guys and Dolls", it was decided to reestablish the summer show as a permanent fixture. Few people would appreciate the very hard work which goes into presenting a production of this scale in such a short time. I know from first hand experience, having called in to a rehearsal in the early stages, just how well the different departments pull together under pressure.

The Company are also to be congratulated in attracting such an array of new young talent which bodes well for the future.

As soon as the run of "The Pajama Game" ends the company will be going straight into rehearsals for their Spring 1999 production which will be a Gilbert & Sullivan 'double bill' – "Trial by Jury" and "HMS Pinafore". I trust we can rely on your continued support for this venture.

And now, I hope you will sit back, relax and enjoy tonight's show.

"The Pajama Game" which opened in New York in May 1954, was still playing to capacity in the 80th week of its run at the St James' Theatre when the eagerly awaited British production was launched at the London Coliseum in October 1955. The Broadway production ran for an incredible 1063 performances and starred John Raitt, Janis Paige and Eddie Foy Jnr. The London production ran for 588 performances and starred Edmund Hockridge, Joy Nichols and Max Wall.

Based on a bestselling novel "71/2 Cents" by Richard Bissell, the show was made into a hit film starring Doris Day and John Raitt.

Inverness Opera Company presented the show in the Little Theatre in 1972 and again in Eden Court in 1981. Interestingly, this is the third time that Calum MacDougall takes the part of Mr Hasler, the owner of the "Sleep Tite Pajama Factory"!

The Story of "THE PAJAMA GAME"

The Sleep Tite Pajama Factory in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, has a new works superintendent, Sid Sorokin. It doesn't take him long to be attracted to Babe Williams, the union's boss of the Grievance Committee. She, of course, denies she's attracted to him. Meanwhile, Hines, the time-study man, is madly jealous of Gladys, a bookkeeper, with whom he's in love. Hines confides his fears to Mabel, another secretary.

Meanwhile, there's a company picnic and the union president makes advances to Gladys – which maddens Hines. Sid makes progress with Babe. Things move fast and at her home Babe reveals a little industrial problem. There's likely to be a strike. Other factories in the group have been awarded a pay rise, but not Sleep Tite. $7^{1/2}$ cents per hour is the sum involved.

At a union rally, Gladys entertains and then freezes Hines out of her affections. She's union and he's management. But she, literally, holds the key that could solve the dispute. This is the key to Mr Hasler's ledgers. Superintendent Sid Sorokin now takes a hand in the dispute. He takes Gladys out to Hernando's Hideaway to get the secret ledger key from her. They are observed there by Hines and Babe, both of whom are suspicious. Sid pleads with them to wait until the union strike rally, at which he confronts Mr Hasler. The 71/2 cents was added to costs months ago. Hasler gives in, Sid gets Babe and the company celebrates with a parade of new pajama fashion styles at Hernando's Hideaway!




